



5 days Mountain Gorillas, Game drives and Boat Cruise Safari

Overview

Here you will visit Queen Elizabeth & Bwindi Impenetrable National Park and participate in activities like Gorilla Tracking, Launch cruise or Boat cruise, Game drives where you expect to see a variety of animals like Tree Climbing Lions, Elephants, Buffaloes, Antelopes, among others. Queen Elizabeth National Park is situated astride the equator in the south western Uganda. Bwindi Impenetrable National Park is found in South Western Uganda on the edge of western rift valley.

Itinerary

Upon arrival, you will be met by your guide from Intanda Falls Tours & Travel who will then transfer you to your Hotel/Lodge a stone throw from Entebbe international airport for relaxation and your overnight stay.

Day 01: Transfer from Entebbe to Queen Elizabeth National Park

After your morning breakfast, you will embark on an exciting drive to Queen Elizabeth National park situated in the shadows of Mt. Rwenzori with several stops along the way for lunch in Fort portal, relaxation, equator and landscape viewing. You will reach the park in the evening and check in to Hotel/Lodge for relaxation, dinner and overnight stay.

Day 02: Game drive and Boat Cruise

After your morning breakfast, you will begin your day with a game drive in the morning where you are likely to see early risers, predators, bush bucks, hyenas, elephants, bush pigs, Lions, buffaloes, climbing lions and jackals. After the drive, you will return to the Lodge/Hotel for lunch and relaxation. In the afternoon, you will go for 3 hrs thrilling launch trip along the Kazinga channel where you are likely to see hundreds of hippos, buffalos, while elephants linger on the shoreline and spot over 60 bird species during the trip. You will return to the Lodge for relaxation, dinner and overnight stay.

Day 03: Transfer from Queen Elizabeth to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

On this day, you will wake up at leisure and have your breakfast before embarking on a journey to the home of Mountain Gorillas, Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. You will enjoy a scenic drive

that allows you to enjoy the beautiful and varied country side with winding roads through a stunning mosaic hill scenery all the way to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. You will arrive in the evening and check in to the Lodge/Hotel for relaxation, dinner and overnight stay.

Day 04: Mountain Gorilla tracking & Batwa Cultural Encounter

After your breakfast, you will hike to the park headquarters just meters from the lodge for a briefing by the park ranger. At 8.30 am, you will be transferred to the starting point for the gorilla trek. Visiting mountain gorillas will take you 3 hours to a full day trek through the forest since the gorillas move from one place to another every day looking for food. The visit will give you a glimpse into the life of a gorilla family and if you are lucky enough to gaze into the eyes of a gorilla, you may sense an immediate connection there. After your Gorilla tracking, you will go for the Batwa cultural experience before returning to the lodge for relaxation, dinner and overnight stay.

Day 05: Transfer from Bwindi Impenetrable National Park to Entebbe/Entebbe International Airport

On this day you will have your breakfast at the Lodge/Camp/Hotel and transfer back to Entebbe having your lunch en -route.

What to bring

- ✓ Wear stout shoes or walking boots suitable for steep muddy slopes.
- ✓ Gardening gloves are excellent in the forest when pulling on vines and nettles and during tree planting activity.
- ✓ Carry rain gear, sunscreen lotion, a hat (as the weather is unpredictable) and insect repellent.
- ✓ Porters are available to hire when need a rise.

Rules and Regulations when you are with Mountain Gorillas

- Keep your voice down or be quiet.
- Don't point or wave your arms because it can be a threat.
- If approached by Chimpanzees, move backwards slowly to keep a 5m distance
- Do not use the flash on the camera as this could cause gorillas to charge.
- Do not mimic
