



## **9 Days Uganda Wildlife Safari in Uganda**

### **Overview**

Here you will visit Murchison Falls, Kibale, Queen Elizabeth & Bwindi Impenetrable National Park & Bigodi wetland and participate in activities like; Mountain Gorilla tracking, Chimpanzee tracking, game drives, boat cruises, guided walk in nature, Batwa trail experience among others.

### **Itinerary**

Upon arrival, you will be met by your guide from Intanda Falls Tours & Travel who will then transfer you to your Hotel/Lodge a stone throw from Entebbe international airport for relaxation and your overnight stay.

#### **Day 01: Transfer from Entebbe to Murchison Falls National Park for an evening game drive**

On this day, you will have your breakfast and drive to Murchison falls National Park. The drive will take you through Luwero triangle and Budongo forest in the western arm of the Rift Valley. Here you will also be rewarded with splendid views of the countryside. You will arrive in the afternoon, have lunch and head for an evening game drive where you expect to view animals like Elephants, Giraffes, Lions, Leopards, Buffaloes, hyenas among others. You will then check in at the Lodge/Hotel/Guest House for relaxation, dinner and overnight stay.

#### **Day 02: Game drive and Boat Cruise**

On this day, you will go for an early game drive to see the early risers plus the predators, jackals, giraffe, antelope, Uganda Kob, hyenas, lion and elephants. You will have your lunch then embark on a 3 hours thrilling boat cruise/launch cruise on spectacular Victoria Nile which will journey you to the spectacular bottom of the Murchison Falls seeing animals like buffaloes, hippos, crocodiles and elephants along the river banks and numerous aquatic birds like the uncommon shoebills plus the fish eagle. You will return to the Lodge/Hotel/Guest House for relaxation, dinner and overnight stay.

#### **Day 03: Transfer from Murchison Falls to Kibale National Park**

On this day, you will have your breakfast at leisure and embark on a drive to Kibale National park with several stops along the way for lunch, beautiful scenery viewing, landscape viewing among others before reaching Fort Portal town and the Park. You will arrive in the evening and check in to the Lodge/Hotel/Guest House for relaxation, dinner and overnight stay.

#### **Day 04: Chimpanzees tracking and Nature walk**

On this day, you will wake up early and have your breakfast before moving to Kibale National Park for morning Chimpanzee tracking activity at Kanyanchu visitors Centre. Here you will also be able to see abundant wildlife including; baboons, red tailed Colubus monkeys, vervet monkeys, black and white Colubus monkey, various bird species, butterflies and many more. You will have lunch then move to a cultural site at Bigodi Wetland for a guided walk in nature, bird and other wildlife viewing before returning to the Hotel/Lodge/Camp for relaxation, dinner and our overnight stay.

#### **Day 05: Transfer from Kibale to Queen Elizabeth National Park for an evening game drive**

After your morning breakfast, you will embark on an exciting drive to Queen Elizabeth National park situated in the shadows of Mt. Rwenzori with several stops along the way for equator and landscape viewing. You will arrive in the afternoon and have your lunch before embarking on your evening game drive where you expect to see animals like elephants, buffaloes, Lions, bush pigs, antelope's families among others. After your evening game drive you will check in to your Hotel/Lodge for relaxation, dinner and overnight stay.

#### **Day 06: Game drive and Boat cruise**

After your morning breakfast, you will begin your day with a game drive in the morning where you are likely to see early risers, predators, bush bucks, hyenas, elephants, bush pigs, Lions, buffaloes, climbing lions and jackals. After the drive, you will return to the Lodge/Hotel for lunch and relaxation. In the afternoon, you will go for 3 hours thrilling launch trip along the Kazinga channel where you are likely to see hundreds of hippos, buffaloes, while elephants linger on the shoreline and spot over 60 bird species during the trip. You will return to the Lodge for relaxation, dinner and overnight stay.

#### **Day 07: Transfer from Queen Elizabeth to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park**

On this day, you will wake up at leisure and have your breakfast before embarking on a journey to the home of Mountain Gorillas, Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. You will enjoy a scenic drive that allows you to enjoy the beautiful and varied country side with winding roads through a stunning mosaic hill scenery all the way to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. You will arrive in the evening and check in to the Lodge/Hotel for relaxation, dinner and overnight stay.

#### **Day 08: Mountain Gorilla Tracking & Batwa Cultural Encounter**

After your breakfast, you will hike to the park headquarters just meters from the lodge for a briefing by the park ranger. At 8.30 am, you will be transferred to the starting point for the gorilla trek. Visiting mountain gorillas will take you 3 hours to a full day trek through the forest since the gorillas move from one place to another every day looking for food. The visit will give you a glimpse into the life of a gorilla family and if you are lucky enough to gaze into the eyes of a gorilla, you may sense an immediate connection there. After your Gorilla tracking, you will go for the batwa cultural experience before returning to the lodge for relaxation, dinner and overnight stay.

## **Day 09: Transfer from Kibale National Park back to Entebbe/Entebbe International Airport**

On this day, you will wake up at leisure for breakfast and then embark on an exciting road trip to Entebbe with a stopover at Mubende town for your lunch. You will reach Entebbe/Entebbe International Airport in the evening ready to catch up your flight back home.

### **What to bring**

- ✓ Wear stout shoes or walking boots suitable for steep muddy slopes.
- ✓ Gardening gloves are excellent in the forest when pulling on vines and nettles and during tree planting activity.
- ✓ Carry rain gear, sunscreen lotion, a hat (as the weather is unpredictable) and insect repellent.
- ✓ Porters are available to hire when need a rise.

### **Rules and Regulations when you are with Chimpanzees and Mountain Gorillas**

- Keep your voice down or be quiet.
- Don't point or wave your arms because it can be a threat.
- If approached by Chimpanzees, move backwards slowly to keep a 5m distance
- Do not use the flash on the camera as this could cause gorillas to charge.
- Do not mimic
